

Ordinance No. 26 - 2

ORDINANCE LEVYING AND ASSESSING TAX FOR LIMESTONE
TOWNSHIP LIBRARY DISTRICT OF THE COUNTY OF KANKAKEE
STATE OF ILLINOIS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING
THE 1st DAY OF JULY, 2026 AND ENDING
THE 30th DAY OF JUNE, 2027

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Limestone Township Library District, in the County of Kankakee and State of Illinois, did on the 16th day of July, 2026 pass the Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance (Ordinance No. 26-1) for said Library District for the fiscal year commencing on July 1, 2026 and ending June 30, 2027; and

WHEREAS, said Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance was duly published as provided by law after its passage;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE LIMESTONE TOWNSHIP LIBRARY DISTRICT, IN THE COUNTY OF KANKAKEE AND STATE OF ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1: That the total sum of THREE HUNDRED EIGHT THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED SEVENTY DOLLARS (\$308,570.00) composed as follows: The sum of THREE HUNDRED EIGHT THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED SEVENTY DOLLARS (\$308,570.00) being the amount deemed required for the necessary corporate purposes of Limestone Township Library District, Kankakee County, Illinois, be and the same is hereby levied and assessed upon and against all taxable property within this Library District according to the full fair value as established and ascertained for

State and County purposes for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2026 and ending June 30, 2027 and the Board of Trustees of the Limestone Township Library District having on the 16th day of July, 2026 duly passed and adopted the Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2026 and ending June 30, 2027 and said Ordinance having been duly published in a newspaper of general circulation within this Public Library District, this Board finds that the specific purposes and the specific amounts provided for in said Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance, a copy of which is attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof, are required to be levied for the necessary purposes of the Limestone Township Library District.

Section 2: The Secretary of the Board of Trustees of the Limestone Township Library District is hereby directed to file a duly certified copy of this Ordinance with the County Clerk of Kankakee County, Illinois, in accordance with the laws of the State of Illinois, on or before the last Tuesday of December 2026; and said County Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to extend the said tax so levied by this Ordinance, according to law, against all taxable property within the Limestone Township Library District. The Secretary of Limestone Township Library District shall also file on or before the last Tuesday of December 2026, duly certified

copies of the Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance and this Ordinance with the Limestone Township Library District where they shall be available for public inspection as provided by law.

Section 3: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as provided by law.

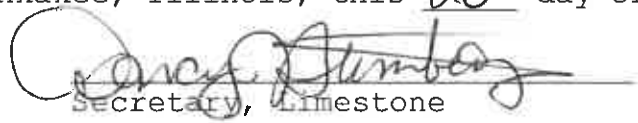
